17-24 1s lead down the middle and back
25-32 1s +2 s dance Poussette. 213

SLYTHERIN HOUSE (S8x32) 3C (4C set) Chris Ronald RSCDS Book 52
1-8 1s+2s Set+Link; circle 4H round to Left. 213
$9-16$ s pull back RSh and cast round 3rd corner (Man up/Lady down), pass LSh in centre and dance LSh round 1 st corner ( 6 bars) 1 s turn $3 / 4 \mathrm{LH}$ to end in centre 1 M below 1 L
$17-201 \mathrm{~L}+2 \mathrm{~s}$ and $1 \mathrm{M}+3$ s dance RH across

21-24 "Snake Pass":-

$33-402 \mathrm{~s}+4 \mathrm{~s}$ dance reel of 4 with Ladies starting by passing LSh
41-48 All set Highland Schottische to corners, turn 2 H twice
49-56 All Ladies circle left to face partners (Ladies BtoB), set to and turn partners 2 H
