Men cast round partner \& dance anticlockwise 1 place, dance LH across \& turn new partner RH to places
33-48 All dance Schiehallion Reel to end facing partner (on corner)
49-56 All dance La Baratte with partner:
49-50 Man 1/2 turns partner RH \& retains hand but at arm's length from each other
51-52 Man retraces steps, taking LH, with Lady turning right under Man's arm briefly into Allemande hold (Man behind Lady facing Lady's original place) \& releasing Lady's RH she turns under Man's left arm until almost in original places
53-54 All couples change places LH to opposite places
55-56 All set ending ready for...
All poussette right round
Repeat in Reel time

Five Traditional Scottish Country Dances for 1965 • Crib: E-cribs
1- $1 \mathrm{c}+2 \mathrm{c}+3 \mathrm{c}$ mirror Reels3 on opposite sides ( 1 c cross down, 2 c out and up)
9- Repeat, 1 c now to own sides
17- 1c lead down ; and up to top to face 2 c from the middle diagonally
25- 1 c set to 2 c | dance to the bottom ( $2 \mathrm{c}+3 \mathrm{c}+4 \mathrm{c}$ up) and turn inwards into ; 4c+1c Circle4 $\mathrm{L}(2,3,4,1)$
